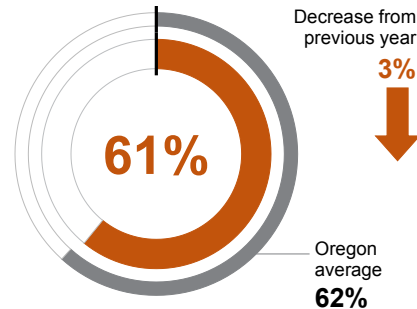

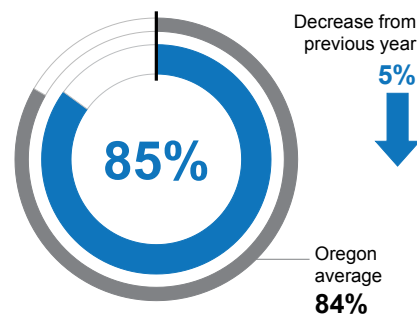
Students who attended more than 90% of their enrolled school days.

### District Goals

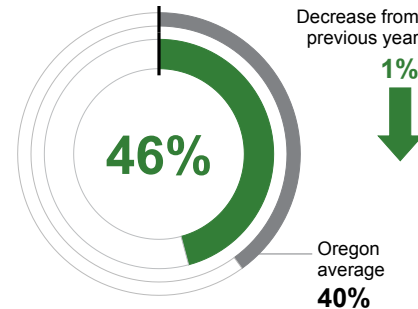

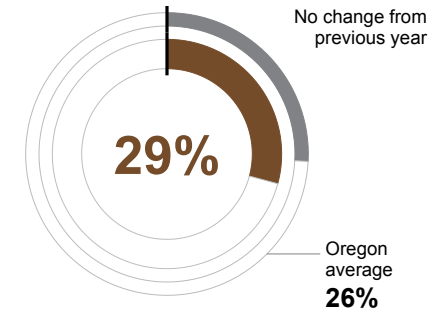
Students meeting state grade-level expectations.

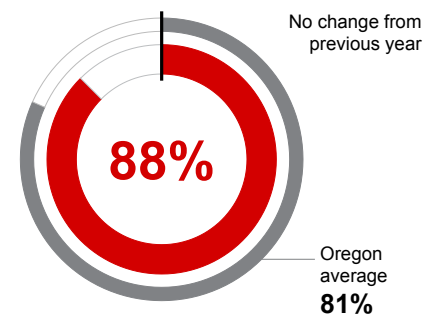

Students meeting state grade-level expectations.



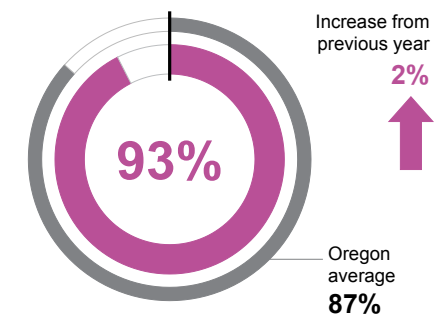
#### ON-TIME GRADUATION

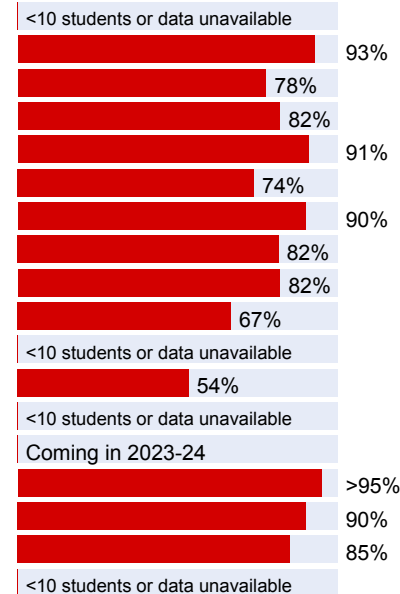

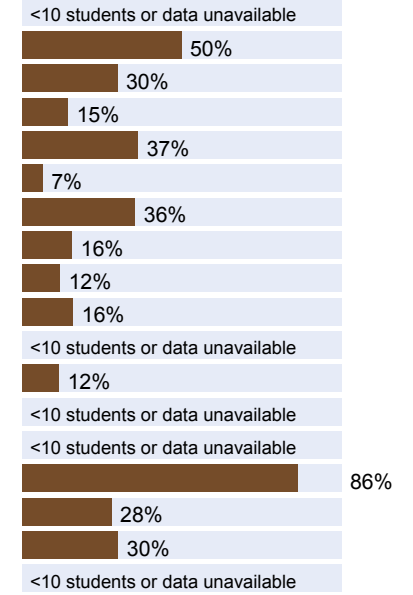
