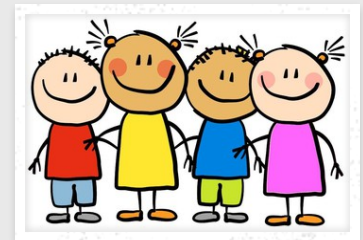

CALLING ALL READERS IN GRADES 3-5!

You are invited to participate in the Oregon Battle of the Books! OBOB is a voluntary reading incentive program developed for 3rd-5th graders. OBOB provides a reading list of 16 books to be read by a 4-5 member team. Typically each student reads 4 books that they are “experts” on, but of course the more they read the better prepared the team will be. There is no requirement for how many books a student reads. Even if they just read one they can still participate. Teams “battle” other teams by answering questions in a quiz show type competition. All practices and battles will be held during school hours with the exception of the winning team that will attend a regional competition in March.

Students may form their own teams within their own grade. **However, students do not need to create a team to participate in OBOB!!!! We will make sure all students are put onto a team.**

- No face paint or masks

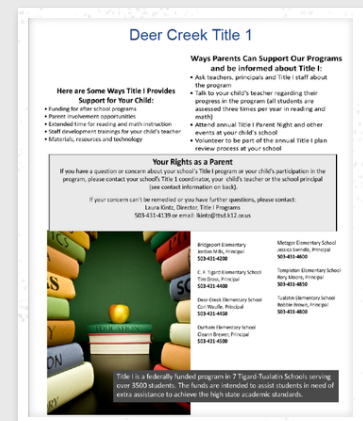
As we look forward to next year, we will be moving our Harvest Parties to November.

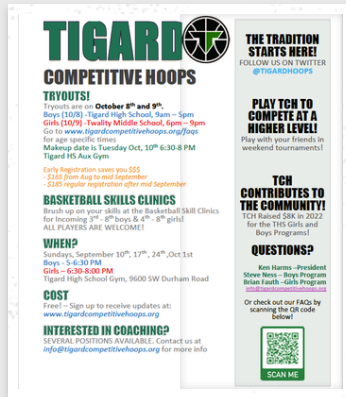
