"experts" on, but, of course, the more they read the better prepared the team will be. There is no requirement for how many books a student reads. Even if they just read one, they can still participate. Teams "battle" other teams by answering questions in a quiz show type competition. Registration is due November 17. STARTING THE PICK UP LINE TOO EARLY IS CAUSING AGGRESSIVE DRIVING AND CONCERNS FROM THE POLICE.

- Kinder and 1st grade family cars may enter the parking lot starting at 2:10pm.
- 2nd-5th grade family cars may enter the lot starting at 2:15pm.
- Please DO NOT begin the pick-up line before 2:10pm. Arriving before this pick-up window
 causes heavy area congestion (in most cases, area gridlock) causing various safety
 concerns. Entering a line that is beginning to move is better than entering a line that won't
 be moving for 30+ minutes.
- Please help us be efficient by staying in your car and quickly leaving the lot once your child is in the car.

This system is designed to be a quick drive through. If you need to help your child with their seatbelt, please pull into a parking spot.


