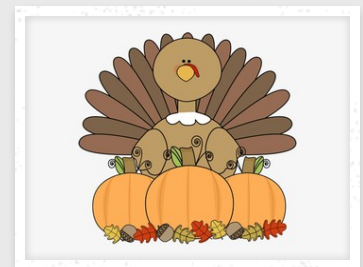

| THE FOLLOWING ARE EXCLUSION CRITERIA: <small>*The list below lists the duration time to stay home. A student may need to stay home longer for some illnesses.</small> | |
| Fever: temperature of 100.4°F (38°C) or greater | *Fever free for 24 hours without taking fever-reducing medicine. |
| New cough/hoarseness | *Symptoms improving for 24 hours (no cough or cough is well controlled). |
| New difficulty breathing | *Symptoms improving for 24 hours (breathing comfortably). Urgent medical care may be needed. |
| Diarrhea: 3 loose or watery stools in a day OR not able to control bowel movements | *Symptoms free for 48 hours OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. |
| Vomiting: one or more episodes that is unexplained | *Symptoms free for 48 hours OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. |
| Headache with stiff neck and fever | *Symptoms free OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. Follow their instructions above. Urgent medical care may be needed. |
| Skin rash or open sores | *Symptoms free, which means rash is gone OR sores are dry or can be completely covered by a bandage OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. |
| Red eyes with colored discharge | *Symptoms free, which means redness and discharge are gone OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. |
| Jaundice: new yellow color in eyes or skin | *After the school has orders from doctor or local public health authority to school nurse. |
| Acting differently without a reason: unusually sleepy, grumpy, or confused. | *Symptoms free, which means return to normal behavior OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. |
| Major health event, like an illness lasting 2 or more weeks OR a hospital stay. OR health condition requires more care than school staff can safely provide. | *After the school has orders from doctor to school nurse AND after measures are in place for the student's safety. Please work with school staff to address special health care needs so the student can attend safely. |

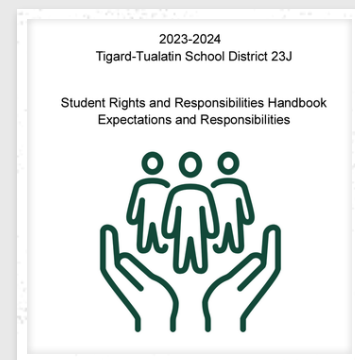

Volunteer process:

The volunteer process must be followed if the person will be interacting with our students. Whether the volunteering will take place during school or after school, the parent/community member must undergo the volunteer requirements as outlined on our website. Background checks:

We are very busy with background checks for new hires and volunteers. Please get your volunteer applications submitted sooner than later so you are approved for activities throughout the year. Volunteer applications are good for 3 years, this includes the background check and the training.
