
Yearbook Cover Contest

TTSD and LifeStance Health have partnered to improve student access to mental health services. The LifeStance Health School-Based Program is dedicated to providing quality therapeutic services to schools while removing barriers for students and families by placing therapists in district buildings. School-Based Therapists treat mental health conditions which can include depression, anxiety, PTSD, ADHD, or substance use issues. Services are billed through OHP and most insurance plans.



LifeStance Health serves all TTSD students K-12 out of two locations:

- 1. Tigard High School
- 2 Ryrom Flementary/Tualatin High School

SYMPTOMS OF ILLNESS	THE STUDENT MAY RETURN AFTER "The list below tells the shortest time to stay home. A student may need to stay home longer for some illnesses.		
Fever: temperature of 100.4°F (38°C) or greater	*Fever-free for 24 hours without taking fever-reducing medicine.		
New cough illness	 Symptoms improving for 24 hours (no cough or cough is well-controlled). 		
New difficulty breathing	 Symptoms improving for 24 hours (breathing comfortably). Urgent medical care may be needed. 		
Diarrhea: 3 loose or watery stools in a day OR not able to control bowel movements	*Symptom-free for 48 hours OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.		
Vomitting: one or more episode that is unexplained	*Symptom-free for 48 hours OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.		
Headache with stiff neck and fever	*Symptom-free OR with orders from doctor to school nurse. Follow fever instructions above. Urgent medical care may be needed.		
kin rash or open sores	*Symptom free, which means rash is gone OR sores are dry or can be completely covered by a bandage OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.		
led eyes with colored drainage	*Symptom-free, which means redness and drainage are gone OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.		
aundice: new yellow color in eyes or skin	*After the school has orders from doctor or local public health authority to school nurse.		
acting differently without a reason: unusually sleepy, grumpy, or confused.	*Symptom-free, which means return to normal behavior OR with orders from doctor to school nurse.		
Anjor health event, like an illness lasting 2 or more weeks OR a hospital stay, OR lealth condition requires more care than chool staff can safely provide.	*After the school has orders from doctor to school nurse AND after measures are in place for the student's safety. Please work with school staff to address special health-care needs so the student may attend safely.

Volunteers and after school events:

Whether the volunteering will take place during school or after school, the parent/community member must undergo the volunteer requirements as outlined on our website. This includes all school and or PTO/PSO sponsored events.

Background checks:

We are very busy with background checks for new hires and volunteers. Please get your volunteer applications submitted sooner than later so you are approved for activities throughout the year. Volunteer applications are good for 3 years, this includes the background check and the training.
