**Foundation Grant** - This year we have \$8,250 with a \$4,882.18 carryover from last year. So for this year we will receive a total of \$13,132.18. We were given the ok to hire Jennifer Brown for more hours to use for pullout for 3<sup>rd</sup> grade math support. This will help since 3<sup>rd</sup> grade will be starting to test in Smarter Balance.

**Continual Improvement Plan (Draft)**

**Academic goal** – Change measure of goal by DIBELS not Smarter Balance.

- **Raising the Bar** – Overall student achievement in reading will increase by 5-10% for all populations of students when comparing composite DIBELS scores from Fall 2017-Spring 2018 (K-5).
- **Closing the Achievement Gap** – The achievement gap in reading proficiency between White and Hispanic students in grades K-5 will decrease by at least 10% as measured by DIBELS, curriculum based measures, grade level formative and summative assessments and district developed assessments by June of 2018.

**Culture/Climate SMART Goals**

- **Raising the Bar** – The percentage of office discipline referrals for physical contact will decrease by 8% from 43% to 35% during the 2017-2018 school year.
- **Closing the Achievement Gap** – The referral risk ratio for our minority students will be equal to that of the white students. On average the risk ratio for minority students was 1.22 and .91 for white students in 2016-2017.

**Equity SMART Goal**

- **Closing the Achievement Gap** – All Deer Creek families will express satisfaction for effective outreach practices as measured by our end of year survey regarding communication and parent engagement by June 2018.

**Portable** – Today they finished the install portion. The portable still needs carpet, electricity and to be inspected. Once that is all done we can move in. The goal is to be in by the end of next week.

**Security** – There will be a fence that goes around the portable that will have a door with a bar to push open like the front doors. It is locked from the outside so students can get out but not in without a key. We will also have back gate that will be locked. There will be a small green space for the 5<sup>th</sup> graders. The District will add plants and flowers.
