Principal's Report | *Cori Waufle*

- Starting on March 14th TTSD schools will be recommended but optional. The schools won't require or ask anyone to wear one.
- Masks will be optional on school buses
- This week they will be talking to students about respecting individual choice regarding masks
- They will no longer be offering the 'test to stay' program or requiring quarantine time for exposure. If someone tests positive, they must stay home for 5 days and be symptom free before returning to school. A negative test will not be required.
- School will still notify families of students that are exposed to a positive case at school and TTSD will still update their dashboard to show known cases
- Volunteers are allowed in the buildings again. Must have completed background check with the district and proof of vaccination required
- No proof of vaccination is required at events or activities. Cori is getting clarification on what is included in that designation to see if it would apply to evening activities on school campus (ex: a book fair)
- After spring break distancing requirements in school will reduce to 3 ft from 6 ft
- If the district returns to a high rate of transmission and case counts, then masking may be reimplemented
- State testing will begin next week with the 5th grade class and continue after Spring Break for the 3rd and 4th graders. Tests will continue thru April and into May
